This will be achieved through the development of respectful relationships and a commitment to safety, embracing appropriate boundaries, behaviours and practices, in accordance with the Archdiocese of Brisbane's *Code of Ethical Behaviour for employees and volunteers who work in service of the Church*, as well as adherence to the legislative imperatives of the State.

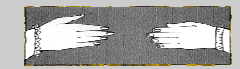
